SCHOOL ANTI-BULLYING SPECIALIST

I. Title: School Anti-Bullying Specialist

II. Qualifications:

- A. Statutory requirements: When a school guidance counselor, school psychologist, or another individual similarly trained is currently employed in the school, the principal shall appoint that individual to be the school anti-bullying specialist. If no individual meeting this criteria is currently employed in the school, the principal shall appoint a school anti-bullying specialist from currently employed school personnel.
- B. Valid New Jersey Teaching Certificate
- C. Knowledge of harassment, intimidation and bullying (HIB) legislation
- D. Strong interpersonal and communications skills
- E. Required criminal history check and proof of U.S. citizenship or legal resident alien status
- **III. Primary Function:** To carry out the statutory duties of the school anti-bullying specialist.
- IV. Reports to: Principal or Designated Administrator/Supervisor

V. Major Duties and Responsibilities:

- a. Chair the school safety team;
- b. Lead the investigation of incidents of harassment, intimidation, and bullying in the school:
- c. Act as the primary school official responsible for preventing, identifying, and addressing incidents of harassment, intimidation, and bullying in the school.
- d. Meet at least twice a school year with the school anti-bullying coordinator, to discuss and strengthen procedures and policies to prevent, identify, and address harassment, intimidation, and bullying in the school.
- e. Speak at a board hearing on the incident if called by the board;
- f. Maintains confidentiality as required and appropriate; and
- g. Performs other duties which may be within the scope of his/her employment and position as may be assigned.
- VI. Terms & Conditions of Employment: To be determined by the Board. The antibullying duties will be in addition to any other existing responsibilities.
- **VII. Evaluation:** Performance of this job will be evaluated annually.
