## What happens at the Child Health Conference?

Nurses and doctors will work with you to help you be the best parent you can be for your child. During your visit to the CHC, you will have the chance to ask questions about your child's health and learn ways to keep your child healthy. You will also learn about how your child grows and develops, what your child should be eating, and what you can do to keep your child safe.

Your child will also receive the following services while at the CHC:

- A physical exam by the doctor or nurse practitioner
- Immunizations to protect your child against a variety of serious illnesses such as polio and measles
- Blood tests to check for anemia and lead poisoning
- Screening tests to check for speech, hearing and/or vision problems



## What if you don't have insurance?

In order to be seen at the Child Health Conference (CHC), the child must either be uninsured or have Medicaid Part A.
